- anyone divorced and attempting remarriage "outside" the Church and lacking the freedom to marry ;
- anyone giving public scandal by their life, or whose conduct is unbecoming.

Be mindful:

At least a two-month advance notice is required; you will be contacted by someone from our parish office in the very near future. Besides on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month (except during Lent) at 1:00 p.m., Baptisms may be celebrated at Sunday Mass, at 5:00 p.m. (Sat.), 9:00 & 11:00 a.m. (Sun.) -- preferably the 1st and 3rd Sundays.
